-ing participles - CYAN HIGHLIGHTS

Adjectives out of order - LIGHT PURPLE HIGHLIGHTS (officially, "light purple 2")

Absolutes - MAGENTA HIGHLIGHTS

When you highlight revision techniques, you MUST HIGHLIGHT THE ENTIRE PHRASE AND NOT JUST THE KEY WORDS!
